

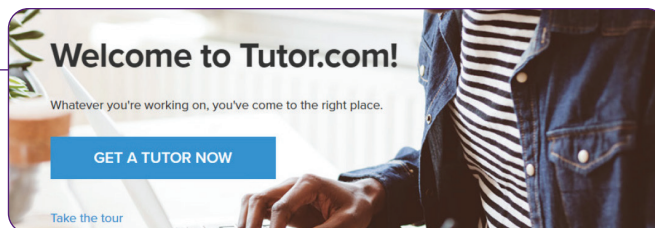
How It Works: Tutor.com Classroom

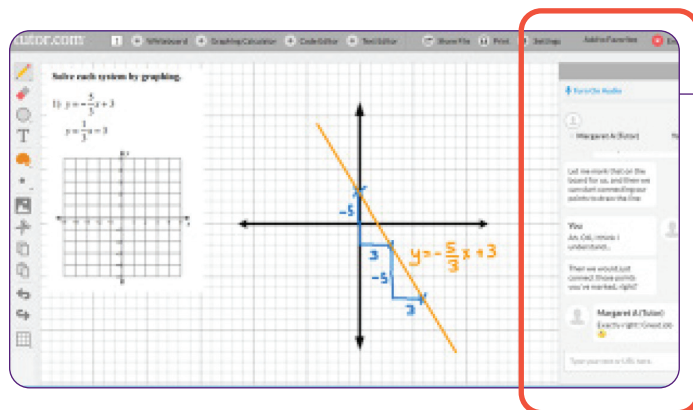

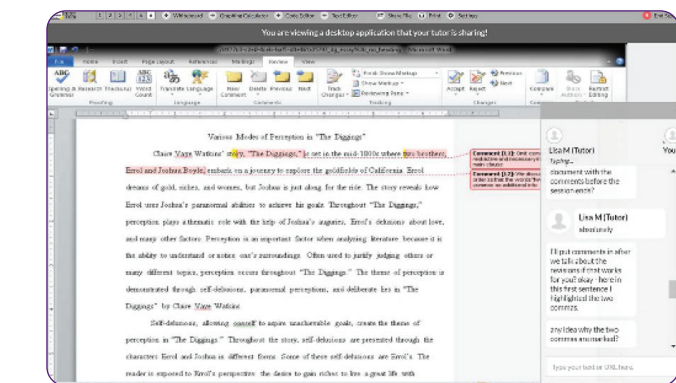


Step 3: Communicate

You can use text chat or an audio connection to communicate with your tutor in the online classroom.* You and your tutor may also use the interactive whiteboard to share work and ideas. *All activity in the classroom is recorded for review and quality control. Transcripts will be available afterward in your student locker.*

Step 4: Share a file

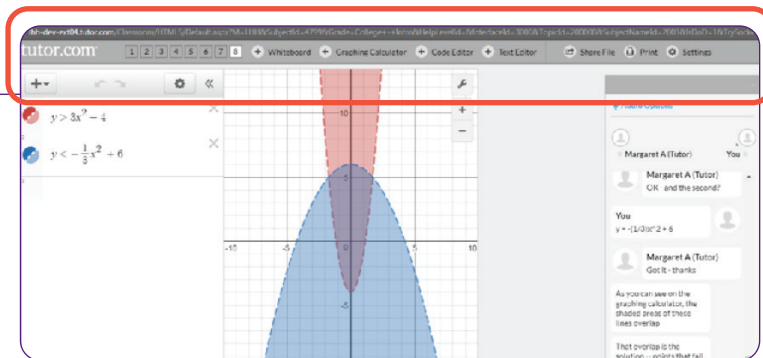
You can upload files related to your assignment to the online classroom—including documents, spreadsheets, PowerPoint presentations, screenshots, image files, and more. You and your tutor will be able to view them together during your session.

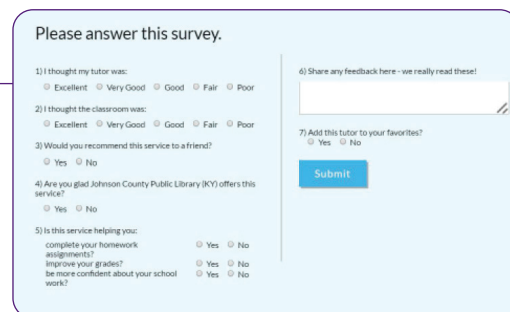
Step 5: Use special tools

The classroom includes a graphing calculator, text editor, and code editor that can be used when working on subject material requiring special tools. You can open them by using the buttons above the whiteboard.



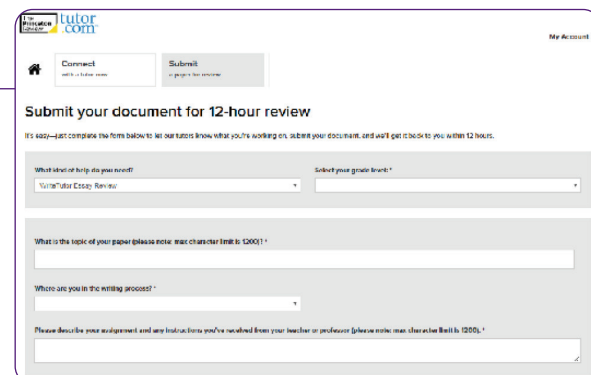
Step 6: Rate and review your session

After each session, be sure to let us know how we did! Complete the survey and share your comments. Then you'll have the option to play a recording of your session and email or print the chat log and whiteboards.



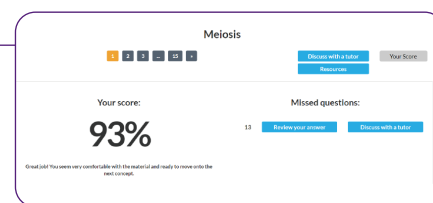
Step 7: Submit your paper
